

9 Hole Disc Golf Course

Brooker Avenue, Christchurch

This is the fourth publicly available course in Christchurch. There is an 18 hole course in Jellie Park (Burnside) and a 9 hole course at Queenspark (Parklands) and an 18 hole course close-by at Ascot Disc Golf Course.

Disc Golf is suitable for all ages. Discs are available from some sports stores in Christchurch, and at vorticadiscgolf.co.nz. The object of disc golf is to complete each hole in the fewest number of throws. A golf disc is thrown from a tee area to a metal basket which is the target. As a player progresses down the fairway, he or she must make each consecutive shot from where the previous throw has landed. The trees, shrubs and terrain changes in and around the fairway provide challenging obstacles for the disc golfer. When the disc finally lands and comes to rest in the chains or basket, the hole is completed.

Please enjoy your round, respect other people using this space and avoid any damage to plants and trees. Pick up rubbish and look after this lovely area!

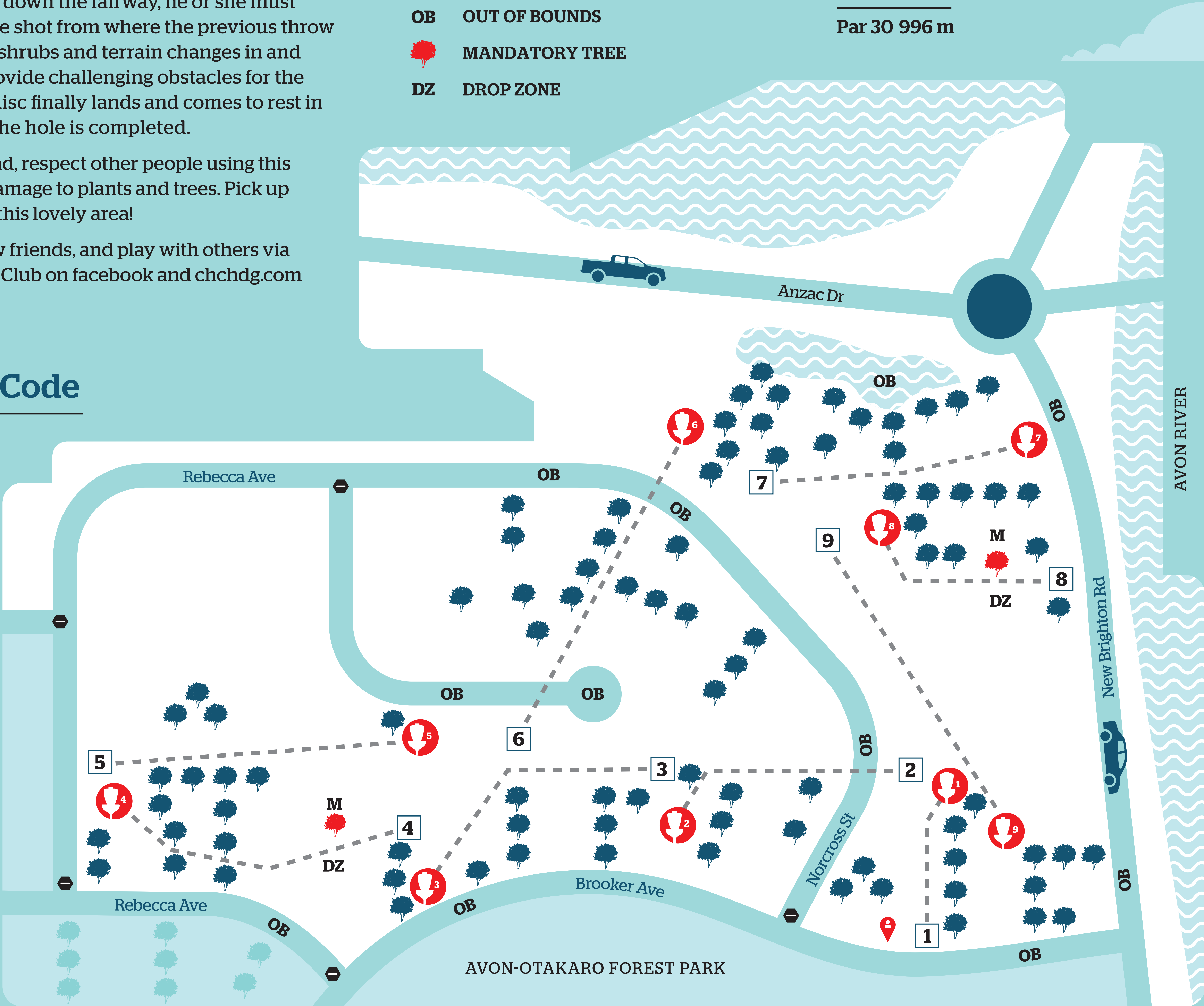
