The Annual General Meeting of NZDG will take place at 6:30 for 7:00 p.m. on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> May by videoconference (Zoom) as scheduled <https://tinyurl.com/95bsjeza>

The Meeting will be open from 6:30 p.m. to allow invitees to join. Please allow time. You will be taken to a virtual waiting room to start with and will be allowed to join the Meeting as soon as a Board Director has checked that you are a current NZDG Member.

You will have already received an invitation to the meeting by e-mail. If you are not on our e-mail list, or your e-mail address is out of date or if you know someone who hasn't received their ballot, please encourage them to email our voting officer (Luke Hetzel) at [luke@franklyweb.nz](mailto:luke@franklyweb.nz) with the email to be used for voting, plus their Name, DOB, and tournament played in the last 12 months.

Voting will re-open during the AGM on Friday May 28<sup>th</sup> from 6:45PM - 7:15PM. Please ensure you have access to your voting email as voting will still be done through the secure online platform. Members are encouraged to vote before the AGM.

When you join the Meeting, you will be muted (not allowed to speak), but you may submit comments via the Zoom chat function, which will be moderated by another Board Director, and passed to the Chairman as appropriate.

For the receiving of reports (and similar), this will be done by a virtual show of hands (which will be explained at the beginning of the meeting).

You will find all the documents you need for the AGM on the Governance page of the NZDG website [nzdg.org.nz/governance](http://nzdg.org.nz/governance) including candidacy letters.

E-voting is open and will close 24 hours before the Meeting. Please don't forget to vote, and please encourage other Members to vote.
